

LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading

HOMILY

LITURGY OF ANOINTING

Celebrant: We now move into our Liturgy of Anointing. God’s tender healing is freely offered to each of us. In a few minutes, you will be invited to experience the healing touch of the Lord through anointing with the sacred oil.

THE BLESSING OF THE OIL

Celebrant: God of all consolation, you chose to send your Son to heal the world. Graciously listen to our prayer of faith: send the power of your Holy Spirit, the Consoler, into this precious oil, this soothing ointment, this rich gift, this fruit of the earth.

Bless this oil + and sanctify it for our use. Make this oil a remedy for all who are anointed with it; heal them in body, in soul and in spirit, and deliver them from every affliction. We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God for ever and ever.

People: Amen.

Celebrant: My friends join with me now in praying with those who are seriously ill, and in praying for them to be healed and strengthened in this time of uncertainty. We pray also for those who have dedicated themselves to caring for the sick, whether in their own homes, hospitals or nursing and care homes.

Our response is: **Heal us, body and soul.**

People: Heal us, body and soul.

PC: For what we have done, and for what we have failed to do.

Abba, Father, if it be possible,

People: Heal us, body and soul.

PC: Lord Jesus, you told us again and again, *'Do not be afraid.'*

INVOCATION OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Blessing for Inner Healing

PC. Stretch forth your strong right hand, O God, and shield your faithful people, that we may seek you with all our hearts and receive those things for which we rightly pray. Grant this through Jesus Christ our Lord.

People. Amen.

(The Clergy lower their outstretched hands)

PC. God of love and compassion, ease the sufferings of all who have gathered here today. Through your healing power, may we experience your healing presence. We make our prayer through Christ our Lord.

People. Amen.

THE ANOINTING

The priests anoint each person in turn.

First, they anoint the forehead saying:

“Through this holy anointing may the Lord in His love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit.”

People. Amen.

Then, they anoint the hands saying:

“May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up.”

People. Amen.

Reader: We pray for our medical teams as they selflessly give of their time and expertise in hospitals, ambulance services, nursing homes and care homes, in supporting patients with the coronavirus.

(pause) Lord hear us.

People. Lord graciously hear us.

Reader: We bring to mind the silent intentions present in our hearts.

(a quiet moment of silence)

We offer all our prayers to God through Mary as we pray:

People. Hail Mary...

Celebrant: Father in heaven, through this holy anointing, grant our sisters and brothers comfort in their suffering. When they are afraid give them courage, when afflicted give them patience, when dejected afford them hope, and when alone assure them of the support of your holy people. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

People. Amen.
